Objectives:

- Develop your understanding of leadership to be the leader you want to be
- Build up your leadership skills.
- Reflect on your leading skills.

Contents: During this short programme you will learn the leadership skills to help you become the leader you want to be in your context, to be as effective as you need to be with today's learners and staff. You will learn and experiment not only with management skills, which ensure things are done right, but with leadership skills, which ensure the right things are done. This requires looking at the educator's beliefs, the overall context and cultures, their teaching and assessment practice, their planning, the learning environment, the resources they use, as well as the relationships they build.

In sum, this programme on leadership for educators includes the following topics:

- leadership,
- engagement, &
- effectiveness.

Most importantly, you will develop and experiment with your own view of leadership and skill set.

Methodology: We will meet every other week to discuss key leadership ideas and share our experimentation. There will be no reading material in between sessions to make it a hands-on, conversational and experience based.
